## Frequently Asked Questions



### What is The Partnership Cancer Fund?

The Partnership Cancer Fund provides financial assistance to cancer patients undergoing treatment with certain medically related expenses.

#### Program Guidelines

- Funds are not available for goods and services obtained prior to date of application
- Applicants are accepted based on availability of funds

#### Eligibility

- Applicant must be currently undergoing treatment for cancer
- Applicant must be a resident of Lowndes County **-OR-** under treatment by a facility or physician in Lowndes County

#### Application

### What type of financial assistance is available?

- Transportation costs to health care facility/physician to obtain cancer treatments and follow up care (currently .10 per mile)
- Nutritional supplements during treatment and up to three months after treatment
- Cost of durable medical equipment as prescribed by a physician and necessary for symptom management
- Cost of medications related to applicant's cancer treatment
