UPDATED VISITOR GUIDELINES

SGMC's top priority is to provide the safest environment possible for our patients, visitors, employees, physicians and volunteers. These guidelines are subject to change at any time.

VISITATION HOURS BY UNIT

- Inpatient units are allowed one visitor at a time: 3W, 4W, 5W, 5S, 4S, 3T, Pediatrics, Smith Northview from 9am-8:30pm
- COVID-19 patients and units are allowed visitors ONLY under special considerations: 2T, 4T, 5T
- Outpatients and emergency room patients are allowed one visitor.
- Labor and Delivery and Post Partum patients are allowed two visitors at a time.
- If you are unsure of your patient's location, please call 229-333-1111 prior to your arrival.
- Overnight stays are not allowed at this time.

VISITOR SCREENING

Visitors can expect to receive a temperature screening and be asked the following questions:

Do you have respiratory symptoms such as cough or shortness of breath? Have you been in contact with someone known or suspected to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days?


If you have a temperature of 100.0° or above or answer "yes" to any of the above questions, you will not be allowed to visit.

VISITORS MUST:

- Receive a brief screening upon entry and an authorization badge.
- Wear the surgical mask provided by the screener at all times while inside the hospital.
- Use hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the hospital and patient rooms.
- Be over the age of 12.
- Practice social distancing while in the facility.
